The yearbook is the most exhaustive annual publication of statistics for the national economy and socio-economic processes. The publication contains ten thematic chapters: geographic characteristics of Latvia; population; labour market; social protection and health; education, R&D and culture; economy and finance; foreign trade; business; information technologies; business sectors; and comparative international statistics. It reflects statistics for 2024 along with comparative data. The figures are presented in tables, charts and maps. The yearbook is based on the information available to the Central Statistical Bureau of Latvia and other institutions obtained from statistical surveys, public registers and various information systems.

5. Children in Latvia 2025

The collection of statistics covers information on the number of children births and deaths, their age composition, state of health, education, social protection, risk of material deprivation and monetary poverty in households with children, employment of minors, use of information technologies, violence against children and children in conflict with law. The statistics covers year 2024 and gives comparisons with the previous years.

Material deprivation covers conditions under which, due to the lack of financial resources, households are excluded from ordinary living patterns. The leaflet contains tables and charts, as well as a short description of indicators characterising material deprivation.

13. Agriculture of Latvia 2025

A collection of statistics containing texts, tables and graphs showing the key statistics for Latvian agriculture in 2020, 2023 and 2024, namely, sown areas, harvested production and yield of agricultural crops, number of livestock, output of animal products, organic farming, average producer prices and indices in agriculture, use of mineral and organic fertilisers, application of pesticides, gross nutrient balances (N and P), grouping of farms by crop area and yield, livestock number, as well as supply balance sheets.

Some variables are given in breakdown by statistical region as well as compared to figures in other Baltic countries.

14. Integrated Farm Statistics 2023

The collection of statistics contains data characterising structure of agricultural holdings – their number and average size, farm type, economic size, land area, utilisation of agricultural area, soil tillage and conservation practices, orchard areas, number of livestock, agricultural machinery and equipment, labour force in agriculture, other gainful activities of the holdings, etc. The statistics characterising surveyed economically active agricultural holdings is compiled and published at national and regional level. Some variables are presented at municipal level or compared with the figures collected in Agricultural Census 2020.

The text, tables and graphs of the informative leaflet cover the key statistics for forest areas, forest stand structure by main tree species, tree species in forest stands of Latvia, total standing timber, average timber volume and forest area in breakdown by type of forest growing conditions, damaged forest stands and those with lost vegetative vigour, nature protection forest areas, afforestation, felling and standing timber areas in breakdown by type of felling, forest regeneration, forest regeneration and tending costs, average forestry costs, purchase prices of coniferous and deciduous sawlogs, forest fires, and game animals.

20. Environment of Latvia in Figures: Climate Change, Natural Resources and Environmental Quality in 2024

The collection of statistics presents information on environmental investment and current expenditure on protection of natural resources and environment (sample survey data). It also contains statistics for emission of polluting substances into the atmosphere from stationary sources, environmental quality, greenhouse gas emissions, consumption of energy resources, natural resources and utilisation thereof (material flow accounts, resources efficiency), forestry and waste management in 2024 along with comparative data. Figures in some tables are broken down by city.

The figures for air protection, environmental quality, air emissions accounts, as well as generation of municipal and hazardous waste were drawn up based on the Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre data.
